



Club rules as of 2024

By entering Windsor Polo Club you agree to the following rules:

SUBJECT	RULE
HELMETS	Currently NSWPA approved riding helmets must be worn (and always secured) by riders
HORSES	Horses must be always under control No changes are to be made or spares to be held in front of the club house Spares must be held within 30 m from the back line
DOGS	Dogs must be on a leash and always restrained
SPECTATORS	Polo involves horses travelling at speed. Spectators must not go onto the field or within 10 metres of the sideline while a game is in progress To avoid injury from a polo ball being hit over the sideline, spectators are asked to keep an eye on the game when play is in progress
PARENTS AND GUARDIANS OF CHILDREN	Parents and guardians must supervise their children at all times which includes ensuring they do not enter the field of play, or sit or stand within 10metres of the sideline while a game is in progress. This supervision extends to adherence of underage drinking laws.”
PLAYERS	Only registered players may take part in NSWPA sanctioned events
POLO FIELDS	Only registered players can ride on the polo fields Stick and balling is permitted on #3 for MEMBERS only
PONY LINES	Northern end pony lines are now for 2024 financial MEMBERS ONLY, this is due to congestion on the lines and to limit vehicles All other players are to utilise the 60 available yards, the pony lines behind the # 2 and the yards & paddocks near the lagoon. There is plenty of space for everyone.
EXTERNAL GATES	New pony lines are to be erected on the Sothern end of the field to utilise the shade of the trees
VEHICLES	External gates are to be kept closed at all times Maximum speed limit of 20km/h anywhere on the property Vehicles travelling from end to end must drive along the mound, respecting the need to stay off the 10 meter safety line off the boards Vehicles must not drive past signage that clearly says No Vehicle Access – i.e. no cars are allowed behind the # 1 field Vehicles must not drive on any part of the grounds that are part of the polo field – i.e. the areas mown short No vehicles maybe parked within 10 metres of the sidelines of the polo field
E WHEELS	Only permitted AFTER all games are finished for the day – Helmets MUST be worn and secured at all times
PARKING	No parking of floats at the northern end of the grounds No parking in the driveway access to the mound between #1 and #2 Yards are available on site but must be booked online prior to arrival
STABLING	Yards must be left clean with chains up and manure cleaned away in designated pooh pits
LITTER	Any litter is to be placed in the rubbish bins provided or taken off the property
ELECTRICAL TAPE	All tape is to be picked up before and disposed of before leaving the grounds
POLO BALLS	Polo balls are property of the club and are not to be taken off the grounds
GOOD BEHAVIOUR	Poor behaviour or disrespect towards other people or animals will not be tolerated and offenders will be asked to leave the property

Northern end pony lines between the No.1 & No. 2:

- Only current financial Windsor Polo Club Members can utilise these pony lines
- All other players are to utilise the 60 available yards, the pony lines behind the No.2 and the yards & paddocks near the lagoon. There is plenty of space for everyone.
- There are no exceptions to this arrangement.

Vehicle traffic:

- Vehicles travelling in that direction must drive along the mound, respecting the need to stay off the 10 meter safety line off the boards.
- Vehicles must not drive past signage that clearly says No Vehicle Access – i.e. no cars are allowed to drive from the driveway to the pony lines behind the No.1 field
- Vehicles must not drive on any part of the grounds that are part of the polo field – i.e. the areas mown short
